Curriculum

We will be learning all about Crime and Punishment (summer 1) and Ancient Egypt (summer 2) this term. Have a look on the attached knowledge organiser to see how much you already know. Can you think of a question you would like to research more about this term? We are planning a Zoom meeting with our local community police officer to learn more about modern day police work too.

In Science we will be investigating human digestion and teeth as well as exploring how plants and animals are grouped and classified.

We will be using keys to identify different species as well as investigating food chains.

In Art we will explore printing and DT we will develop our sewing skills to

create an item from recycled fabrics. This will link back to work we did on protecting the environment in the Spring term

In computing we will learn about effective internet searches, using Logo and exploring animation and music making packages.

Spellings and Reading

All children are expected to read at least 3 times a week and record this in their reading diary.

We will continue to encourage all children to read for pleasure, picking texts that interest them.

Please remember that the children have weekly spellings which will be tested on a Friday.

Guitars

Our guitar teacher will continue to



work with the children fortnightly on a Tuesday afternoon, teaching them both guitar and music skills.

Resources

The children have become very responsible and show this by taking care of their own resources in school.

Can we remind you that they only require 1 bottle of hand sanitizer, 1 water bottle and a pencil case.

Toys and other items from home should not be brought into school.

Showbie

We will continue to update Showbie through the term. Each week we will include the weekly spellings in case your paper copy is mislaid. You will also find the weekly menus, links to reading apps and materials and information about homework

tasks. Please remember we do not check Showbie on a daily basis when at school so important messages should still be passed to staff at the P.E. door.

Our P.E. specialist Mr. Jones will continue working with Year 4 teaching the children on a Thursday afternoon.

Please ensure they come to school with suitable outdoor PE kit.

Jewellery We have a no jewellery P.E. policy in school. Therefore, during P.E. lessons the children must remove all earrings and watches, for their P.E. lessons and it will be their responsibility to look after them themselves.
