




Does your child have access to the Internet at home?




If 'Yes', what Internet-linked devices do they use on a regular basis? 78 responses




Do you know how to set the privacy and security settings on these devices to ensure they are unable to access inappropriate content?




During an average week, how many hours does your child spend online using any of these devices?






Does your child have access to / use any of the following social media / sharing apps / websites? 78 responses




Do you know, and could you teach your child, the privacy and security settings that should be set on these social networks?






