


<u>Rise Park Curriculum Map – Year 6 (Theme Week)</u>

Areas of Learning (Wider curriculum links)

As artists, we will be creating a mural of Marcus Rashford, including positive messages of support for him and anyone else who may be trolled and racial abused online.

As readers, we will be exploring the book 'Marcus Rashford – You are a Champion. How to be the best you can be.' We will be looking at what inspired Rashford and hot seating him to find some answers to our questions. We will also be reading about his tips on being the best versions of ourselves.

We will be exploring what makes us proud and why it is important to be proud of ourselves.

We will be exploring what we have already achieved in our lifetimes and what we would like to achieve.

We will be exploring key vocabulary such as discrimination and prejudice to understand what it means.

Emotional Awareness

Children will discuss their achievements and what makes them proud. They will explore why it is important to be proud of themselves.

Children will explore how online trolling can affect peoples' mental health.

Possibilities & Enquiry

Children will make a mural of positive messages to Marcus Rashford and other people who have been racially abused online.

Knowledge of the world

Children will explore why online trolling happens and how they can deal with it.

Children will learn about what Marcus Rashford has done to help other people in the UK.

Diversity

Children will learn about why racial abuse happens online and what people are doing to tackle it.
