## 5 Plagues of Reading:

- Archaic language books written over 50-100 years ago.
- Non-linear time sequences where the story doesn't always move in chronological order such as use of flash-backs.
- Narratively complex books with unreliable or multiple narrators.
- Figurative text texts that happen on a symbolic level.
- Resistant texts texts that deliberately resist easy mean-making by readers.
