5 Plagues of Reading:

- **Archaic language** – books written over 50-100 years ago.
- **Non-linear time sequences** – where the story doesn't always move in chronological order such as use of flash-backs.
- **Narratively complex** – books with unreliable or multiple narrators.
- **Figurative text** – texts that happen on a symbolic level.
- **Resistant texts** – texts that deliberately resist easy mean-making by readers.
