# <u>Title: Year 3 – Proud to Be Theme Week</u>



#### **Areas of Learning** (Wider curriculum links)

As historians, we will research the key achievements and moments of pride in Captain Tom Moore's life and plot these on a chronological timeline.

As readers, we will enjoy reading biographies of Captain Sir Tom Moore - "Tom Moore - Little People, Big Dream" and "Captain Sir Tom Moore - One Hundred Steps." We will explore his achievements and the difference he made to the lives of others. We will discuss what makes him such an inspirational person and how we can be more responsible citizens by following in his footsteps. In shared reading, we will further explore the non-fiction genre, learning about its key features and answer a range of VIPER questions on NCR on Captain Sir Tom Moore.

As Global Citizens, we will explore the diversity of cultures and societies within and beyond own experience and share the contributions of different cultures to our lives. We will value what contributes to our own identity. We will understand impacts of prejudice and discrimination and discuss ways to adapt our behavior to take in ton account feelings of others, building a belief that individuals and groups can improve situations.

As geographers, using the text "One Word Together" we will extend our knowledge locality as we learn more about cultures around the world.

As artists we will develop our line drawing skills as we create images which represent features of our lives, personalities that bring us pride.

Explore how we recognize feelings of pride and the impact this has on our physical and mental health.
