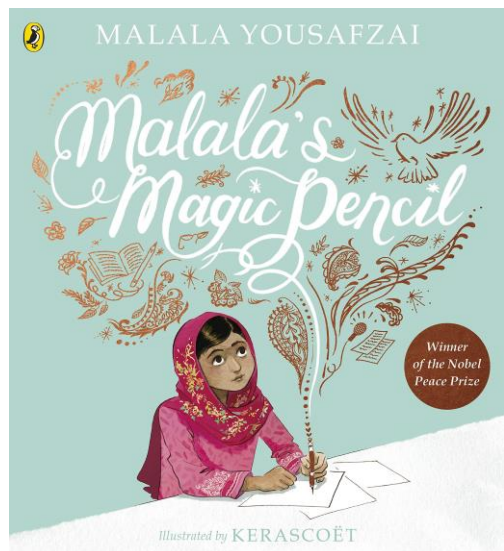




Rise Park Curriculum Map Year 5 Autumn Theme Week



Title: Proud To Be – Malala Yousafzai



Areas of Learning (Wider curriculum links)

Over the course of the week, we will focus on the life of Malala Yousafzai, learning about her achievements, the discrimination she has faced and how she has been a force change.

As readers we will develop our reading skills in fluency and comprehension through dissecting the fictional novel “Malala’s Magic Pencil.”

As writers we will use knowledge gleaned from this story to consider how we could be a force for positive change, both on a national and international scale, considering how we can make a realistic impact. We will also complete a fact file on Malala, which will give us the opportunity to reflect upon the achievements that we believe she should be proud of and how she still could face discrimination today.

As evolving digital leaders, we will use iPad software to present our work and findings from the week to another year group across school.

We will learn about the discrimination that other people can face because of their gender and consider the impact that this can have on their lives.

Using iPad software, we will have the opportunity to create our own presentation about the life of Malala Yousafzai to show to other pupils.
