Disability

Areas of Learning (Wider curriculum links)

Explore what it means to be deaf

Understand how deaf people communicate

Explore different methods of communicate and their limitations

Reflect on what makes good communication and how we could make our classroom more accommodating for deaf people

Learn to sign the alphabet

Investigate how deaf people are included and can access activities

Challenge stereotypes about deaf people

Explore a role model (Rose Ayling-Ellis) and how she is a role model for deaf people

Take responsibility for sharing knowledge with others and creating greater awareness

Emotional Awareness

Understand how others might feel in a situation. Reflect on own behavior toward people with disabilities

Possibilities & Enquiry

Question why people might be treated differently

Knowledge of the world

Learn a new language (sign language)
