

Mother's Day Events

Thank you for booking your Mother's Day Event. The booking form has now closed. Please read the following information regarding your event.

Key stage 2 Mother's Day Event (years 3-6) will take place on Monday 13th March 3:30-4:00pm in your child's classroom.

You will collect your children as usual from the classroom door at 3:15pm.

If you have a child in key stage 1 or reception, you can take them to the key stage 1 hall via the meeting room door (near to the canopy on the key stage 1 playground). A staff member will be there to direct you. Your children will be looked after by staff for half an hour whilst you enjoy the event with your key stage 2 child.

If you do not have a younger sibling in key stage 1 or reception, please wait outside your child's classroom until all of the children have been dismissed. You will then be able to re-enter the classroom to enjoy the event.

If you have more than one child in key stage 2, you can choose one classroom to go to and have all your key stage 2 children together.

Key Stage 1 Mother's Day Event (years 1 and 2) will take place on Tuesday 14th March 3:30-4:00pm in the key stage 2 hall.

You will collect your children as usual from the classroom door at 3:15pm.

If you have a child in key stage 2 or reception, you can take them to the key stage 1 hall via the meeting room door (near to the canopy on the key stage 1 playground). A staff member will be there to direct you. Your children will be looked after by staff for half an hour, whilst you enjoy the event with your key stage 1 child. Please enter the event through the key stage 2 hall door next to the disabled parking bay.

If you do not have a sibling in key stage 2 or reception, please take your child directly round to the key stage 2 hall and enter the event through the door next to the disabled parking bay.

Nursery Mother's Day Event will take place on Tuesday 14th March 8:20-8:50am in the key stage 1 hall. Please enter through the Elephants door (next to the key stage 1 playground).

If you have other children in school, they can attend breakfast club free of charge on that day. Please ensure your child comes through the school office so they can be signed in for breakfast club and let the office know that you are attending the Mother's Day Event.

If you have a child who attends afternoon nursery they can attend the event with you and either go home after and attend afternoon nursery as usual or stay for the morning session on this day. Please let the teacher know if you would like to change to a morning session on this day.

Reception Mother's Day Event will take place on Friday 17th March 8:20-8:50am in the key stage 1 hall.

Please enter through the Elephants door (next to the key stage 1 playground).

If you have other children in school, they can attend breakfast club free of charge on that day. Please ensure your child comes through the school office so they can be signed in for breakfast club and let the office know that you are attending the Mother's Day Event.
