Title: Theme Week: Our Community



As readers, we will be exploring how individuals can affect their community through acts of kindness and charity.

As Geographers, we will explore our school environment using maps and aerial photographs to locate areas which we feel could be improved, and to draw where and what improvements could be made.

As writers, we will be sharing our ideas with the governors by writing letters explaining our improvements and asking if they could support us in funding our project.

As artists and designers, we will work together to design a mural to be painted near KS1 / Year 3 classrooms depicting all elements of our wonderful community from friends and family, school, healthcare, shops and care homes.



Possibilities & Enquiry:

We will be investigating and asking questions relating to their local environment and how this could be improved. To understand who to ask for help and support in improving our environment.

Knowledge of the world:

To use maps and aerial photographs to explore and plan improvements to our immediate environment.
To understand the structure / hierarchy of the school e.g. who to ask to make improvements—we will be writing to the governors.

Diversity:

We will be including all children so we must consider age, ability and needs. We will also consider what the wider Rise Park community consists of and how we can incorporate this into our learning environment.

Emotional Awareness:

We will be discussing how our immediate environment can affect our emotional well being, and how spending quality time outdoors can support our learning as well as well being.
