


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Reception Spring 1 2025	<u>Our Learning</u>
Our focus books This half term our 3 key books are 'My mum is a Supermum', 'Busy People - Firefighters' and 'Busy People – Police Officer'. Police Officer Firefighter Firefighter	 This half term our topic is 'Heroes and Helpers.' We will be learning about people who help us and discussing different jobs in our community. We will be arranging a visit from a local police officer and will have the opportunity to explore a real-life fire engine. In maths we will continue our learning about numbers to 10. We will be exploring these numbers by counting, chanting, comparing quantities as well as exploring how they change by adding and subtracting. We will continue to focus on 2D shapes and begin to look at 3D shapes, patterns and measures. In phonics we will continue teaching phase 3 phonemes which will include digraphs and trigraphs. We will also be working on our blending for reading and segmenting for writing skills. We will also be exploring the season Winter and will learn about how Lunar New Year is celebrated in different countries.


