# Year 5 Autumn Term Newsletter 2020


## Welcome back!

We, the Year 5 team, are thrilled to welcome our new classes back to school. We have been hard at work, making sure that everything is ready and safe for the children's return, and we are looking forward to a wonderful term ahead of us. The autumn term is always vitally important in building foundations for the rest of the school year; this means that getting back into a school routine quickly being in on time and being in school every day - will be vitally important to both your child's progress and their well-being.

#### Curriculum

This term our topic is 'Exploring our Environment'. As part of this, we will be learning about rainforests in geography, writing our own rainforest descriptions and stories in English and using watercolours to paint rainforest scenes in art. The wider curriculum will also develop the children's

skills and knowledge



#### PE

We will have one PE session every week. This term our session is on a Wednesday morning, led by our PE specialist Mr. Jones. The children will need to come to school in their kit on this day. Suitable PE clothing includes wearing trainers, a white t-shirt and navy / black shorts or jogging bottoms. They will also need to make sure that they are not wearing earrings and that any long hair is tied back. Please make sure coats are brought in, as our PE sessions will take place outside.

#### Homework

The children will be given weekly spelling words to learn at home. Please support us in our drive to improve standards in by reading and spelling encouraging your child to learn their words and by supporting them in reading as often as possible at We would also appreciate it if you could encourage your children to access Times Tables Rock Stars a couple of times each

#### Equipment

All equipment will be provided by school apart from crayons and felt-tip pens. Please make sure that these are purchased and brought into school, where they will stay in your child's pack. Your child with also require a labelled re-usable water bottle, which will need to be brought into school every day.
