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Dear Parents / Carers,

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Staff in Key Stage Two will be using technology to teach and set work on a regular basis, helping our pupils to stay focused in what is an important year in their education.

Going forwards, we will be using 'Showbie' to set work. It is available as both an app (Showbie) and website (<https://my.showbie.com>), which should hopefully mean that *most* children, if not all, will have access to it while away from school.

Most of our pupils who have been in school recently will have had the opportunity to set up an account. They will have created a username and have set up their own password, which they will have a record of. This will allow them to access their Showbie assignments.

For those children who have been off school, their first step is to 'sign up'. They will need to put in their (real!) first and last names, create a username and password. An email address is not needed.

After that, you will need to join your class:

- For 6H/Argentina, the class code is LLHAJ
- For 6L/Nicaragua, the class code is UK2QK
- For Science, the class code is RLKWP

Your child will now be ready to use Showbie!

As staff, we will set 'Assignments', where we will introduce, explain and/or set work. We might show the children informative pictures, upload activity sheets, leave group or personalised voice memos or upload videos to help explain what the assignment is.

The expectation is that then children will respond to these assignments. This could take place in many forms, from replying to questions through the app, taking pictures of their work to send to staff or recording voice memos with their answers.

Staff will send work throughout the week, so please check your account regularly for new assignments or feedback. Please do not expect instant responses from staff: we will endeavour to maintain communication as often as possible but we may also have to contend with illnesses in our households and families.

In Year 6, we will also, where possible, link assignments to the work packs that have been/will be sent out.
