Title: Enterprise Theme Week – Planning a Healthy Tuck Shop



Areas of Learning (Wider curriculum links)

Over the course of the week, we will introduce our task, research possible items to sell, consider how we will need to advertise our tuck shop and problem solve along the way.

As readers and digital leaders, we will use our skills to research possible items to sell at our tuck shop that will encourage children to want to make healthy snack choices on the KS2 playground.

As environmentalists, we will learn about the pitfalls of single-use plastic and build upon our prior knowledge of Fairtrade goods in order to make eco-friendly choices in both our purchasing and selling for our tuck shop.

As mathematicians and entrepreneurs, we will discuss profit margins, debating the prices that we can sell our healthy snacks at, so that they are both competitively priced and a potential source of income for the school.

As writers and artists, we will work diligently to advertise our potential tuck shop, considering how we can use linguistic and artistic features to promote the items on sale in order to encourage KS2 children to purchase them.

Emotional Awareness

We will discuss some of the risks that can be associated with money (that it can be won, lost and stolen) and how we can keep it safe.

Possibilities & Enquiry

We will have the opportunity to research the price of healthy foodstuff and we will debate sensible profit margins that allow us to run a successful tuck shop.

Knowledge of the world

We will understand what is 'good value for money' and how this concept could impact our sales. We will learn how people's spending decisions can impact others and the environment through Fairtrade and single-use plastic conversations.

Diversity

We will understand that people have different attitudes towards spending and saving money, and how they spend in accordance with their wants and needs.
