National Space Centre

Dear parents / carers,

We are pleased to announce that on Wednesday 21st June, Year 5 will be visiting the National Space Centre in Leicester for a day of wonder and adventure!

In the summer term, our focus topic in science is 'space', where we begin to understand life beyond earth, looking at the planets across our solar system. During our trip to the National Space Centre, we will have lots of opportunities to make our classroom learning come to life, as well as having access to the Planetarium Show.

Please send your child dressed in their normal school clothes on the day. A coat may be needed, depending on weather. A small rucksack or backpack will also be needed to carry their lunch and any inhalers that are required.

Your child will require a healthy snack, a packed lunch and a drink to take with them on the day – no glass bottles, fizzy drinks or items containing nuts please.

If your child is entitled to free school meals and will need a packed lunch, please let either the office or Year 5 team know by Friday 16th June. If your child has any new, specific dietary requirements (e.g. dairy / gluten free), please make us aware of these as well.

Please ensure that your child is at school for 8.25am on the day as the bus will be leaving at 8.45am. Children will need to enter school through the Year 5 door as normal. We should return before the end of the school day (by 3.15pm) and children will be dismissed from their classroom door; we will let you know if there are any delays due to traffic.

The cost of the visit is £16.50 per child. Please send this to school by Monday 19th June.

Your child will **not** need to bring any spending money **nor** will they need to bring a camera with them on this trip. It will be their responsibility to look after their own belongings.

It is important that all children listen carefully to all of the instructions given by both the staff on site and the Rise Park staff. Any children on the day who choose not to listen to or follow any of the instructions given to them, or whose behaviour is a cause for concern, may lose their right to take part in certain activities.
