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Dear Parents and Carers,

We are delighted to welcome you all back into school this term for our summer production of '**Hoodwinked**'

Our Year 6 pupils will perform the lead roles throughout this musical; Years 3, 4 and 5 will each have their own song to perform. Pupils from Years 5 and 6 will take part in both dress rehearsals and they will be required to stay after school for both of the late afternoon performances. Classes from Years 3 and 4 will each have one dress rehearsal and one late afternoon performance.

When booking tickets, please use the information below to help you select the correct performance:

Mexico and Peru:

Dress Rehearsal: Tuesday 2nd July at 9.30am
After School Performance: Tuesday 2nd July at 4pm

Dominican Republic and Cuba:

Dress Rehearsal: Thursday 4th July at 9.30am
After School Performance: Thursday 4th July at 4pm

Chile, Costa Rica, Argentina and Nicaragua:

Dress Rehearsal 1: Tuesday 2nd July at 9.30am
Dress Rehearsal 2: Thursday 4th July at 9.30am
After School Performance 1: Tuesday 2nd July at 4pm
After School Performance 2: Thursday 4th July at 4pm

Doors will be open roughly around 15 minutes before the start of each performance.

When it is your child's after school performance, they will need to stay at school at the end of the school day on those dates to get changed into their costumes and prepare for the start of their show at 4pm. After their performance has finished, they will need to be picked up from outside of their classroom from around 5.15pm, as we estimate that the production will last for about one hour.

Tickets for each performance, including the dress rehearsals, will cost £1.00 to help recover some of the costs spent on the licensing of the script. **Tickets will be available to buy from the office from Monday 17th June and they will be required to guarantee entry for each performance.** There are a limited number of spaces available for each performance, so please buy your tickets in advance. **We will not be selling tickets on the door for either of our 4pm performances.** If you wish to bring babies or young children in prams with you to a performance, please book tickets for one of our dress rehearsals due to space requirements in our hall.

Initially, there will be a limit of 2 tickets per family. There *may* be further tickets available closer to the performance dates – you will be able to enquire about the availability of additional tickets from Wednesday 26th June.

Messages will be sent out about the costumes needed for each class and, in a few cases, separately to individual children playing main characters. Please make sure that items of clothing are sent in (preferably in a named bag) on Monday 24th June.

Thank you in advance for your support with all of the above. The children and staff have put a lot of effort into this production and the children cannot wait for you to see them perform!
