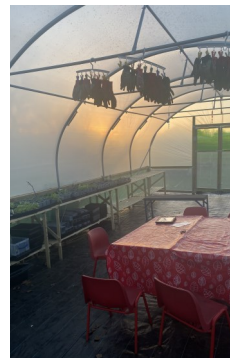

Emotional Coaching Coffee Morning...

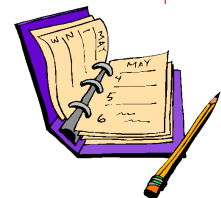
