



Dear Parents/Carers

Linked to our 'Creatures Big and Small' topic in the first half of the Summer term, the children in F2 will be visiting Stonebridge City Farm, for half a day on Thursday 30th April.

The trip will include transport, a tour of the farm gardens, time feeding their larger animals (cows, pigs, goats and sheep) and time to discover and find out about the other animals that live on the farm.

The Elephant class will be leaving school at 9.15am by coach and returning at 12.15pm.
