PSHE: Changing Me

This half term, our PSHE learning will focus on the 'Changing Me' unit. Through a series of age-appropriate lessons, children will explore how people grow and change throughout their lives, including physical, emotional and social changes. The unit also supports children in developing a positive understanding of themselves, building self-esteem, and learning about healthy relationships and personal safety.

We understand that parents and carers may wish to know more about the content being taught. Therefore, there will be an opportunity

to view the resources and planning for this unit, and to ask any questions you may have, at the end of the school day on **Monday 8th June (for Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 2) and Tuesday 9th June (for Years 3, 4, 5 and 6)**

Please be reassured that all learning is carefully planned to be age-appropriate and is delivered in accordance with the statutory guidance set out by the Department for Education (DfE). Our aim is to provide children with accurate information in a safe, supportive and sensitive environment. Thank you for your continued support.

Transition Into Reception

Our oldest children will be leaving Nursery at the end of the Summer Term and transitioning into Reception. We have started to talk to the children about the changes and they will have additional visits to their new classes in July. We are holding a short information meeting for all our parents, whose child will be moving into Reception in September. This will be held after school on Tuesday 9th June 3.30pm - 4.00pm, where

Your holiday will not be authorised and you must talk to the school before you book anything.
Because your child will miss 5 school days you will be given a penalty notice fine.
The fine is £160 but if you pay it in 21 days it will be reduced to £80.
